★ MARTIN WONG: 'VOICES'

(through Feb. 6) This excellent exhibition complements the Bronx Museum of Art's current retrospective of Wong's poignant, street-wise Magic Realist paintings and is nearly equal in size and substance. Organized from the artist's estate by Anneliis Beadnell and Dino Dincer Sirin, it includes art-school ceramics and early paintings full of promise, dazzling quick sketches, poems written in a spiky calligraphy on hanging scrolls and late paintings that point Magic Realism in a new direction.
